## Autumn 1



### ENGLISH

We will read a wide range of fiction and non-fiction texts and use these to learn all about: Retelling stories with familiar settings.

Book for hook: Snorgh and the Sailor!

We will begin the unit by making predictions about the book and completing a range of writing based on the text.

### MATHS

This half term, we will be beginning our work on a range of new topics, this includes:

- Representing, subtracting & addition, ordering and estimating numbers to 1000
- Roman numerals
- Rounding numbers
- Measurements

We will continue to learn and become more confident with our times tables, ahead of our Y4 multiplication test this coming month.

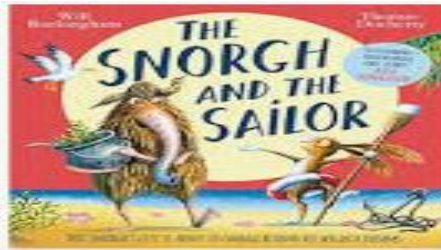
### Art

This term, we will be comparing different artists and portraits whilst creating our own using various techniques.

### PE

This half term, the children will be having a PE lesson on a Monday with Active Tameside and on a Friday w/Mr Lindsay. Please ensure children come to school in the correct PE for both days – we will be focusing on Tag-Rugby!

During these lessons, children will focus on hand/ eye co-ordination, teamwork and invasion skills.



### FRENCH

In French, we will be learning how to tell the time using the consolidation of numbers we did last half term.

### COMPUTING

This half term, we will be exploring alternative uses of the internet safety.

### SCIENCE

This half term, we will be focusing on Animals including Humans. In Year 4, we will be learning about individual areas such as the digestive system, teeth and the human

### HISTORY

For our History unit, we will be studying Ancient Greece – a study of Greek life and achievements and their influence on the western world.
