### ENGLISH

We will read a wide range of fiction and non-fiction texts and use these to guide our writing.

This half term, we will be beginning our work on a range of new topics, this includes:

- Fractions: Whole numbers and mixed.

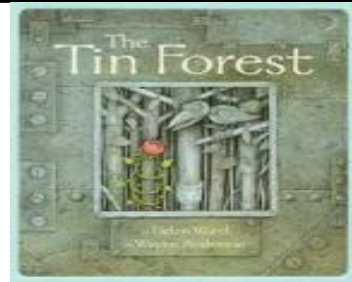
We will continue to learn and become more confident with our times tables, ahead of our Y4 multiplication test this coming year.
