Dear All,
Another half term completed, and it's been a really busy one! 2 key pieces of information for you this week so please read on carefully regarding PE days next half term and also information regarding how to sign up for parental consultations.

Unfortunately, there have been several reported incidents over the last calendar year of inappropriate behaviour, aggressive behaviour or online abuse and harassment towards school personnel. This is **not** acceptable and will **not** be tolerated.

We have 3 school rules – **"be ready, be respectful and be safe"** and I expect this at all times from all personnel entering the school grounds or interacting with the school community.

I have re-sent the parental code of conduct out with this newsletter to remind a very, very small number of adults that should this behaviour be reported I will consider contacting the IEB/ Governors to have those highlighted, banned for the school. The IEB, Diocese head office, Tameside Local Council, OFSTED, the police and legal services have been informed of incidents over this time period already. We ask all visitors to only enter the school site or engage with staff, children and other adults around our school at a time when they are able to conduct themselves in line with these requirements. We are all working very hard to build a better school, community and world...please join us in this journey, as we **ASPIRE** for your children, and work with us at all times

- Y6 Swimming on Friday again. (After Christmas Y6 will return to 2x PE lessons in school each week)

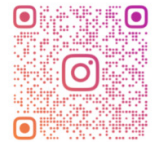
**Parental consultations:
