What will my child need?

- Suggested clothing list we will send this out closer to the time.

- Clothes will be washed and tumble dried
- Outdoor shoes need to be suitable for countryside (wellington boots are provided when appropriate)
- Tracksuits/jogging bottoms jeans are not suitable
- Where possible, children's names should be in clothing
- No mobile phones, electronic devices or cameras!
- No aerosol sprays
- Packed in one bag/case luggage label to given to child on the day
- Need to bring outdoor coat, not to be packed away for walk up to castle.
- No food required to be sent from home as lunch will be served when we arrive

Timings for leaving/returning

- Children to arrive at school for 8:30am and leave their case/bag in the hall.
- Medium sized suitcases only please!
- On Wednesday afternoon, we will leave High Adventure in the afternoon and aim to be back at school by 3:30pm at the latest.
